Exhibitors should be aware that the ever changing Covid-19 conditions could cause this trial to be cancelled in the future. We all hope that will not become necessary.

Crating available:

Most crating will be along two sides of the ring on grass; bring shade & stakes.

Set-ups are to be 10 ft apart.

Limited in car crating.

Special limits: Due to local Covid-19 conditions, entries are being limited based on the number of handlers.

Move ups: No same day move ups. Move ups for Sunday closes 20 minutes after the last run on Saturday.

Day of Show Entries:

Post-closing date and day-of-show entries allowed until entries are closed.

Refunds:

Full Refunds (Checks shredded)

- (1) For cancellations prior to closing date.
- (2) **If trial is cancelled for Covid-19 related reasons, entry checks will be shredded.**
- (3) If you cannot come because you are sick or have been in contact someone that is sick. Contact the Trial Secretary immediately.

Brief Summary of Rules:

Please refer to www.nadac.com for a full explanation of all NADAC rules and up to date information.

- Please note that NADAC trials should provide a safe and fun environment for both exhibitors and their dogs.
- Aggressive dogs will not be tolerated and will be excused from the trial.
- The show committee has the right to refuse any entry. Anyone not currently in good standing with NADAC will not be allowed to enter this trial.
- Exhibitors, through submission of entry, acknowledge that they are knowledgeable of NADAC rules and regulations, and agree to abide by all rules in effect at the time of this trial.
- No entry fee will be refunded if the trial cannot open or be completed by reasons of riots, civil disturbances, fire, acts of God, public emergency, an act of a public enemy, or any other cause beyond the control of the organizing committee.
- Checks not honored by the bank do not constitute a valid entry fee. There will be a \$25.00 service charge for bank returned checks.
- Dog must be registered and have a valid registration number before entries will be accepted. <http://nadac.com/afrm/dogregfrm.asp> A copy of the current Exhibitors Handbook may be downloaded free from the NADAC web site: www.nadac.com
- Bitches in heat, lame, or blind dogs are ineligible for entry, as is any dog with a deformity which may cause a judge to not be able to reasonably assess the dog's ability to function and perform agility obstacles safely, and in a manner that is in the best interest, health and welfare of the dog.
- No food, clickers, or other aids or devices shall be permitted on the course or within 10 feet of the ring. Food or a small non-audible toy can be in a secure container (ziplock bag is acceptable) in your pocket during your run but it cannot be used during your run, nor can you indicate to the dog it is there. Only Intro and Novice handlers may bring a non-audible toy into the ring for training purposes. They cannot earn a Qualifying score and must declare to the judge they are training before they commence their run. Please read the Exhibitor's Handbook for more information about toys and training in the ring.
- The sponsoring clubs will not be responsible for the loss or damage to any dog exhibited, or for the possessions of any exhibitor whether the result be accident or other cause. It is distinctly understood that every dog at this event is in the care and control of his owner or handler during the entire time the dog is on the show premises.

AGREEMENT

The person who signs this agreement represents that he/she is authorized to enter into this agreement on behalf of both exhibitor and the owner of entered dog. In consideration of acceptance of this entry:

- 1.1. As used here "NADAC" means the North American Dog Agility Council, LLC, its members, officers, directors, employees, show chairs, show committees and agents.
- 1.2. Exhibitor/owner agree to abide by the rules and regulations of NADAC and any other rules and regulations appearing in the premium for this event.
- 1.3. Exhibitor/owner certify that the entered dog is not a hazard to persons, dogs or property and that the entered dog's rabies vaccination is current in accordance with the requirement of the state in which the dog resides.
- 1.4. Exhibitor/owner acknowledge all hazards presented by the event and the event premises, including, but not limited to, the condition of the surface, restrooms, security measures or lack of, electrical appliances, fittings, show rings, parking areas and the presence of unfamiliar animals and people; exhibitor and owner assume the risk of any harm arising from these.
- 1.5. Exhibitor/owner releases NADAC (including its respective officers, directors, employees, and members), Palomar Agility Club (including its officers, directors, members, and event organizing committee), equipment provider, Agape Ranch Dog Sports and site owner (including their officers, agents, and employees) and will defend them and hold them harmless from all present and future loss, injury, damage, claims, demands and liabilities involving the entered dog, the event or event premises. Without limiting the generality of the foregoing hold harmless provisions, exhibitor/owner hereby specifically assumes sole responsibility for and agrees to indemnify and save the aforementioned parties harmless from any and all loss and expenses (including legal fees) by reason of the liability imposed by law upon any of the aforementioned parties for damages because of bodily injuries, including death, at any time in consequence of my (our) participation in this event, howsoever such injury or death may be caused and whether or not the same may have been caused or may have been alleged to have been caused by negligence of the aforementioned parties or any of their employees or agents or any other persons.

Exhibitors and guests agree to follow the rules placed upon all persons on the site by the club and property owner/manager. General rules and guidelines will be distributed as part of the final confirmation package. This includes, but not limited to, items like picking up after your dog, properly disposing of all trash, following posted signs, staying within the area assigned to the club for this event by the property owners/managers, and following special Covid-19 rules and guidelines.

The club nor its members will not be responsible for the loss or damage to any dog exhibited, or for the possessions of any exhibitor whether the result was by accident or any other cause. It is distinctly understood that every dog at this event is in the care, custody, and control of his owner or handler during the entire time the dog is on the show premises. Any exhibitor whose dogs and/or children/guest create unnecessary disturbances or repeatedly engage in unsafe or disruptive behavior may, at the discretion of the Show Committee or judge, be asked to leave the show site. In such case, no refund of fees paid will be made and no scores will be submitted.

Palomar Agility Club cannot guarantee your safety and good health. PAC is making many adjustments to help make this trial as safe as possible. We realize that some of these adjustments will be too much for some people and not enough for others. We will provide the highlights of our trial plan so you can make your own decision on what is best for you. Remember, despite all the plans PAC puts in place, you are still responsible for yourself and need to be aware of and follow the basics: WEAR MASKS AS DIRECTED, WASH YOUR HANDS OFTEN AND MAINTAIN SOCIAL DISTANCING. THANKS.

Run Pricing Information

The Per Run rate allows you to combine the total number of runs for all dogs in the same household. Same household = Dogs owned by family members living in the same house. Example: 1 weekend pkg = 14 run + 3 runs for another dog = 17 totals runs.

Pre-Closing Per Run Fee: 1-5 runs = \$14.00 6-12 runs = \$13.00 13 or more runs = \$12.00
Jr Handlers \$8.00 per run

Weekend Pkg (all 14 runs same dog) 1st dog = \$154.00, Each additional dog's weekend package = \$147.00 (Example: If you have 2 dogs doing all runs: \$154 + \$147 = \$301)

Adding runs at trial: If the trial has not filled, for dogs already entered may add runs at the rate paid at time of original entry. (If you entered 1 run at pre-closing rate \$14.00, then at the trial you add 2 more runs. These runs will be \$14 each, not the "day-of-show" rate.)

Day-of Show Entries: After closing, entries will be accepted until limits are reach and/or entries are declared closed. Rate is \$20 per run or \$30 for both rounds of same class/same day/same dog.

*SPECIAL WELCOME TO PAC-NADAC

Welcome Special: PAC wants to welcome handlers that have never competed in NADAC, and those that have not competed at a PAC trial since January 1, 2018 by offering them a special discount.

Pre-closing rate: Discount of \$2.00 off per run for dogs in the same household. (Maximum discount of \$56.00) Additional runs will be at a rate of \$10.50/run for those entered prior to the closing date. This includes Junior Handlers.

Day-of Show Entries (After closing) Discount of \$1.00 per run/same household. (Maximum discount of \$28.00 until limits are reached/entries closed.

*The special Welcome rates do not apply to new dogs whose handler/owners have entered a PAC trial since 1/01/2018.

This is a Containerized Trial. At all NADAC trials exhibitors can enter the ring with a closed/sealed container (a zip lock bag works well) in the pocket of their pants whether it's a containerized trial or not. The container must not be visible to the dog or anyone else and may not be opened within ten feet of the ring boundary. The difference between a containerized trial and a non-containerized trial is that when a club hosts a containerized trial, no one may leave treats or toys around loose, either ringside or at their set up.

Use of toys - Intro and Novice handlers may bring a toy into the ring for a training run, but cannot earn a Qualifying score. You must declare you are training at the start of your run, not in the middle or end. This is only allowed at the Intro and Novice Level.

DIRECTIONS TO SITE:

Please do not drive RVs up the narrow dirt drive between the 1st ring and dog runs. Park in the dirt lot just south of the 1st ring. Reason: Fire regulations, narrow alley, low branches, and limited turn around area.

- **From I-15 Southbound:** Exit on Centre City Pkwy. Turn left at West El Norte Pkwy. Turn left at East Valley Pkwy. Next, turn right on to Lake Wohlford Rd. Go approximately 5.2 miles to 26417 N Lake Wohlford Rd. Make a sharp turn right onto downhill dirt driveway.
- **From I-15 Northbound:** Exit on Via Rancho Pkwy, which becomes Bear Valley Pkwy, continuing until it ends at East Valley Pkwy Turn right onto East Valley Pkwy. Next, turn right on to Lake Wohlford Rd. Go approximately 5.2 miles to 26417 N Lake Wohlford Rd. Make a sharp turn right onto downhill dirt driveway.
- **From CA-78 East: CA-78** becomes E. Lincoln. Continue on E. Lincoln Ave. Turn right on El Norte Pkwy, continuing to East Valley Pkwy. Turn left on East Valley Pkwy. Next, turn right on to Lake Wohlford Rd. Go approximately 5.2 miles to 26417 N Lake Wohlford Rd. Make a sharp turn right onto downhill dirt driveway.
- **Alternate RV Route:** After turning left (north) on to East Valley Pkwy, drive about 4 miles past Lake Wohlford Road; up and over the summit. Near the bottom of the grade, turn right at the light on to Woods Valley Road. Follow Woods Valley Rd about 4 mi. until it intersects w/ North Lake Wohlford Road. Turn right (south) at stop sign, drive approx. 0.7 mile to 26417 N Lake Wohlford Rd, turn left (east) onto the downhill dirt driveway.

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SPECIAL COVID-19 POLICIES AND TRAIL OPERATION RULES

A lot of information regarding Covid-19 policies and special trail operation rules will be sent out with your final confirmation package. It is very important that you read all of it. If after reviewing all the materials, you find you are not in agreement with the terms, or are unable/unwilling to follow the rules and guidelines, contact the Trial Secretary at PAC-Agility@Outlook.com to have your entry withdrawn and your check destroyed. Persons found not in compliance at a trial will be asked to comply or asked to leave.

Here are a few of the current rules/guidelines regarding the measures we are taking to help prevent the spread of Covid-19. Please understand that there will be more in the final confirmation package and that the items cited below may be revised. Please read carefully.

- **Assumption of Risk Waiver:** The club must hold a signed the Assumption of Risk and Waiver of Liability Relating to Corona Virus/Covid-19, for everyone on the trial grounds, including minor children. PAC must have these documents for each person in your party before you will be allowed to run. RETURN THE SIGNED DOCUMENT WITH YOUR ENTRY.
- **Agape' Ranch Dog Sports Waiver** – The site owner's waiver must be signed by all persons that come onto the property. This waiver must sign at least one time each calendar year. You can find the waiver at <https://www.agaperanchdogsports.com/sign-a-waiver> Please indicate on your entry you have completed this waiver. Thanks ☺
- **Illness and Covid Contact:** If you are sick or have come into contact with someone that is sick within 14 days of the trail weekend, please stay home and contact the trial secretary right away. You will receive a FULL REFUND. If a Club suspects an exhibitor is ill, they will ask that exhibitor to leave trial grounds immediately.
- **Personal Protective Equipment (PPE):** While there will be a small supply of items available, each person is responsible for bringing their own PPE; face masks, hand sanitizer, note paper, pen/pencil (to record your scores and write on ribbons). Bring a sufficient quantity for the entire trial. Dispose of all used PPE properly.
- **Sanitization Stations and Rest Rooms:** There will be several sanitation stations on the site that will include hand sanitizer (HS). Restroom are in the form of port-a-potties.
- **Face Masks and Social Distancing:** Cloth masks that cover nose and mouth must be worn when walking around the grounds and anytime time social distancing cannot be maintained. Exhibitor may remove their mask once they are in the ring to run their dog, assuming distance is maintained from judge, bar setters, and leash runner. Replace your mask before leaving the ring. A face shield maybe worn in addition to a cloth mask. Gaiters are discouraged as the materials often do not provide adequate protection level.
- **Longer days:** Exhibitors should expect longer days than experienced at previous trials, due to the extra steps PAC and the judge must take in our efforts to make this event as safe as possible. Please stay flexible as we all learn the best way to run a successful trial under these unusual conditions.
- **Course Maps and Scores:** These will be posted. Suggest you take a photo of the appropriate pages and review at your set up.

- **Walk Throughs:** Depending on entry size, the number of people per walk through may be limited. Masks are required.
- **Crating/Set Ups:** 10 feet between set ups. It can get windy, so please bring necessary stakes etc. Weather permitting a few may be able to crate in their cars.
- **Parking:** Please try not to crowd each other as some exhibitors may be kenneling in their vehicles. An alley must be maintain to allow for emergency vehicles to drive down the lane and turn around easily at the end.
- **Workers:** Palomar needs your help to make this trial successful! Information on how to volunteer will be included with your Preliminary Confirmation. PAC thanks you in advance.
- **Leashes –** We might not have a leash runner for all classes, so be prepared to carry your own leash, have your own leash buddy or use two leads. While there are several options, handlers are encouraged to take their leash with them on course. Handlers may tuck their leash completely into a pocket, secured it around their waist, or sling it over their shoulder. (You cannot run with it draped around your neck.) If the leash falls out or the dog grabs for the leash to play, it will be considered a toy and the run may be eliminated. If your leash will not fit completely into your pocket you might want to consider bringing a confirmation or kennel/vet lead to use.
- **Hospitality:** No hospitality will be provided at this trial. Please bring your own lunch, snacks, beverages, dog treats and water.
- **Spectators/Visitors:** Under current conditions we need to limit the number of people at the site. If you must have a visitor (non-exhibitor) accompany you please note that EVERYONE on the site must have a signed Assumption of Risk and Waiver of Liability Relating to Corona Virus/Covid-19 for both NADAC and Agape'. Spectators/visitors need to identify the exhibitor they are on site with on their signed documents. They can note this in the margin. Reminder, this also applies to all minors. Please print an extra copy of the waiver(s) attached to the premium or see Trial Secretary for paper copies of these waivers.
