FEO accepted if trial does not fill. Dog must be at least 18 mos, registered with NADAC, and jump at least 1 jump height lower than their Proficient jump height. No placements or qualifying scores.

Pre-Entries Close on:

Saturday Oct 16th, 2021 by post mark.

Crating available:

Most crating will be along two sides of the ring on grass. Bring shade & stakes. Limited in car crating.

Entry limits: 425 runs per day.

Move ups: No same day move ups. Move ups for Sunday closes 20 minutes after the last run on Saturday.

Day-of-Show Entries:

Late entries and day-of-show entries allowed until trial if full.

Refunds:

Full refunds (check shredded) will be issued for cancellations prior to closing date.

Cancellations after the closing date for bitches in season or injured dogs may be subject to an administrative fee not to exceed 35%. Trial Secretary must be notified immediately.

There will be no refunds in the event a dog and/or handler are dismissed from competition, regardless of the reason for such dismissal.

No entry fee will be refunded if the trial cannot open or be completed by reasons of riots, civil disturbances, fire, acts of God, public emergency, an act of a public enemy, or any other cause beyond the control of the organizing committee.

JUMP HEIGHTS

There are four Standard Division-Proficient jump heights: 8", 12", 16", and 20". There are four Standard Division-Skilled jump heights: 4", 8", 12", and 16". There are four jump heights for the Veterans and Junior Handler divisions: 4", 8", 12", and 16".

Brief Summary of Rules:

Please refer to <u>www.nadac.com</u> for a full explanation of all NADAC rules and up to date information.

- Please note that NADAC trials should provide a safe and fun environment for both exhibitors and their dogs.
- Aggressive dogs will not be tolerated and will be excused from the trial.
- The show committee has the right to refuse any entry. Anyone not currently in good standing with NADAC will not be allowed to enter this trial.
- Exhibitors, through submission of entry, acknowledge that they are knowledgeable of NADAC rules and regulations, and agree to abide by all rules in effect at the time of this trial.
- No entry fee will be refunded if the trial cannot open or be completed by reasons of riots, civil disturbances, fire, acts of God, public emergency, an act of a public enemy, or any other cause beyond the control of the organizing committee.
- Checks not honored by the bank do not constitute a valid entry fee. There will be a \$30.00 service charge for bank returned checks.
- Dog must be registered and have a valid registration number before entries will be accepted. <u>https://www.nadac.com/register-your-dog/</u>
- A copy of the current Exhibitors Handbook may be downloaded free from the NADAC web site: www.nadac.com
- Bitches in heat, lame, or blind dogs are ineligible for entry, as is any dog with a deformity which may cause a judge to not be able to reasonably assess the dog's ability to function and perform agility obstacles safely, and in a manner that is in the best interest, health and welfare of the dog.
- No food, clickers, or other aids or devices shall be permitted on the course or within 10 feet of the ring. Food or a small non-audible toy can be in a secure container (ziplock bag is acceptable) in your pocket during your run but it cannot be used during your run, nor can you indicate to the dog it is there. All handlers may bring a non-audible toy into the ring for training purposes. They cannot earn a Qualifying score and must declare to the judge they are training before they commence their run. Please read the Exhibitor's Handbook for more information about toys and training in the ring.
- The sponsoring clubs will not be responsible for the loss or damage to any dog exhibited, or for the possessions of any exhibitor whether the result be accident or other cause. It is distinctly understood that every dog at this event is in the care and control of his owner or handler during the entire time the dog is on the show premises.

AGREEMENT

The person who signs this agreement represents that he/she is authorized to enter into this agreement on behalf of both exhibitor and the owner of entered dog. In consideration of acceptance of this entry: 1.1. As used here "NADAC" means the North American Dog Agility Council, LLC, its members, officers, directors, employees, show chairs, show committees and agents.

1.2. Exhibitor/owner agree to abide by the rules and regulations of NADAC and any other rules and regulations appearing in the premium for this event.

1.3. Exhibitor/owner certify that the entered dog is not a hazard to persons, dogs or property and that the entered dog's rabies vaccination is current in accordance with the requirement of the state in which the dog resides.

1.4. Exhibitor/owner acknowledge all hazards presented by the event and the event premises, including, but not limited to, the condition of the surface, restrooms, security measures or lack of, electrical appliances, fittings, show rings, parking areas and the presence of unfamiliar animals and people; exhibitor and owner assume the risk of any harm arising from these.

1.5. Exhibitor/owner releases NADAC (including its respective officers, directors, employees, and members), Palomar Agility Club (including its officers, directors, members, and event organizing committee), equipment provider, Agape Ranch Dog Sports and site owner (including their officers, agents, and employees) and will defend them and hold them harmless from all present and future loss, injury, damage, claims, demands and liabilities involving the entered dog, the event or event premises. Without limiting the generality of the foregoing hold harmless provisions, exhibitor/owner hereby specifically assumes sole responsibility for and agrees to indemnify and save the aforementioned parties harmless from any and all loss and expenses (including legal fees) by reason of the liability imposed by law upon any of the aforementioned parties for damages because of bodily injuries, including death, at any time in consequence of my (our) participation in this event, howsoever such injury or death may be caused and whether or not the same may have been caused or may have been alleged to have been caused by negligence of the aforementioned parties or any of their employees or agents or any other persons.

- Exhibitors and guests agree to follow the rules placed upon all persons on the site by the club and property owner/manager. General rules and guidelines will be outlined in the briefing. These includes, but not limited to picking up after your dog, properly disposing of all trash, following posted signs, staying with in the area assigned to the club for this event by the property owners/managers, and following special Covid rules and guidelines that maybe in effect.

- The club nor its members will not be responsible for the loss or damage/injury to any dog exhibited, or for the possessions of any exhibitor whether the result was by accident or any other cause. It is distinctly understood that every dog at this event is in the care, custody, and control of his owner or handler during the entire time the dog is on the show premises. Any exhibitor whose dogs and/or children/guest create unnecessary disturbances or repeatedly engage in unsafe or disruptive behavior may, at the discretion of the Show Committee or judge, be asked to leave the show site. In such case, no refund of fees paid will be made and no scores will be submitted.

- Palomar Agility Club and its members cannot guarantee your safety and good health. You are responsible for yourself and all animals and persons in your party.

Run Pricing Information

The Per Run rate allows you to combine the total number of runs for all dogs in the same household. Same household = Dogs owned by family members living in the same house. Example: 1 weekend package = 14 run + 3 runs for another dog = 17 totals runs.

Pre-Closing rate: Runs for dogs in same household = 1-6 runs @ \$14.00/run, 7-15 @ \$13.00/run, 16-28 @ \$12.50, 29+ runs @ \$11.50 Jr Handlers \$8.00 per run

Weekend packages: One dog all 14 runs @ \$12/run (\$168.00). Two dogs, 14 runs each (28 runs) @ \$11.50/run (\$322.00)

Day-of-Show (includes entries postmarked after closing date): \$20 per run or \$30 for both rounds of same class/day/dog Jr. Handlers: \$9.00 per run.

***SPECIAL WELCOME TO PAC-NADAC**

Welcome Special: PAC wants to welcome <u>handlers</u> that have never competed in NADAC, and those that have not competed at a PAC trial since January 1, 2019

- Pre-closing rate: Discount of \$2.00 off per run for dogs in the same household. (Maximun discount of \$56.00) Additional runs will be at a rate of \$11.50/run for those entered prior to the closing date. \$2.00 discount also applies to Junior Handlers.
- Day-of-Rate: For entries received after closing a welcome discount is \$1.00 per run; maximum discount \$28.00. Additional runs at the rate of \$15./run. \$1 discount applies to Jr Handlers.

*Welcome rates do not apply to new dogs who's handler/owners have entered since 1/01/2019.

SPECIAL RULES

Containerized Trial - At all NADAC trials exhibitors can enter the ring with a closed/sealed container (a zip lock bag works well) in the pocket of their pants whether it's a containerized trial or not. The container must not be visible to the dog or anyone else and may not be opened within ten feet of the ring boundary. The difference between a containerized trial and a non-containerized trial is that when a club hosts a containerized trial, no one may leave treats or toys around loose, either ringside or at their set up.

Agape' Ranch Dog Sports Waiver – The site owner's waiver must be signed by all persons that come onto the property. This waiver must sign at least one time each calendar year. You can find the waiver at https://www.agaperanchdogsports.com/sign-a-waiver Please indicate on entry completion of waiver.

Leashes – We might not have a leash runner for all classes, so be prepared to carry your own leash or have a leash buddy. While there are several options, handlers are encouraged to take their leash with them on course. Handlers may tuck their leash <u>completely</u> into a pocket, secured it around their waist, or sling it over their shoulder. (You cannot run with it draped around your neck.) If the leash falls out of pocket or the dog grabs for the leash, it may be considered a toy and the run may be eliminated. Pocket leash...It is suggested you verify it will fit completely in your pocket before leaving home.

RULE CHANGES:

- Effective Jan. 11, 2021 all levels may take a **toy in the ring** for use during a non-qualifying run. All rules regarding toys in ring still apply; see rule book.
- Effective June 1, 2021 dogs 15 months and older may enter Intro. (One year testing period.)
- Effective now Associate Membership and Dog Registration is free for Junior Handlers
- New "Grounders" class to debut on January 1st of 2022. A combination of Hoopers and Barrelers.

DIRECTIONS TO SITE:

Please do not drive <u>**RVs**</u> up the narrow dirt drive between the 1st ring and dog runs. Park in the dirt lot just south of the 1st ring. Reason: Fire regulations, narrow alley, low branches, and limited turn around area.

- From I-15 Southbound: Exit on Centre City Pkwy. Turn left at West El Norte Pkwy. Turn left at East Valley Pkwy. Next, turn right on to Lake Wohlford Rd. Go approximately 5.2 miles to 26417 N Lake Wohlford Rd. Make a sharp turn right onto downhill dirt driveway.
- From I-15 Northbound: Exit on Via Rancho Pkwy, which becomes Bear Valley Pkwy, continuing until it ends at East Valley Pkwy Turn right onto East Valley Pkwy. Next, turn right on to Lake Wohlford Rd. Go approximately 5.2 miles to 26417 N Lake Wohlford Rd. Make a sharp turn right onto downhill dirt driveway.
- From CA-78 East: CA-78 becomes E. Lincoln. Continue on E. Lincoln Ave. Turn right on El Norte Pkwy, continuing to East Valley Pkwy. Turn left on East Valley Pkwy. Next, turn right on to Lake Wohlford Rd. Go approximately 5.2 miles to 26417 N Lake Wohlford Rd. Make a sharp turn right onto downhill dirt driveway.
- <u>Alternate RV Route</u>: After turning left (north) on to East Valley Pkwy, drive about 4 miles past Lake Wohlford Road; up and over the summit. Near the bottom of the grade, turn right at the light on to Woods Valley Road. Follow Woods Valley Rd about 4 mi. until it intersects w/ North Lake Wohlford Road. Turn right (south) at stop sign, drive approx. 0.7 mile to 26417 N Lake Wohlford Rd, turn left (east) onto the downhill dirt driveway.
